## **Public Transit**

Please note that these do not bring you to Wet Planet. You will need to make additional arrangements.

### Amtrak

Travel between Portland and Bingen/White Salmon in less than two hours. A one-way ticket costs between \$11-14.

### Greyhound Bus

Offering multiple stops in Portland and one stop in Hood River and The Dalles. Prices range from \$23-30 for one-way tickets.

### Columbia Area Transit (CAT)

Using the Columbia Gorge Express, this is the most consistent and easiest option to travel from Portland to Hood River using the Columbia Gorge Express. A one-way fare is \$10. A local one-way ticket costs \$1.

Additionally, CAT offers Dial-a-Ride service, which allows people to schedule a custom pick-up and drop-off location within Hood River County. This fare is only \$2.
